1. Once on E-resources page, scroll down and click on “Ebrary”

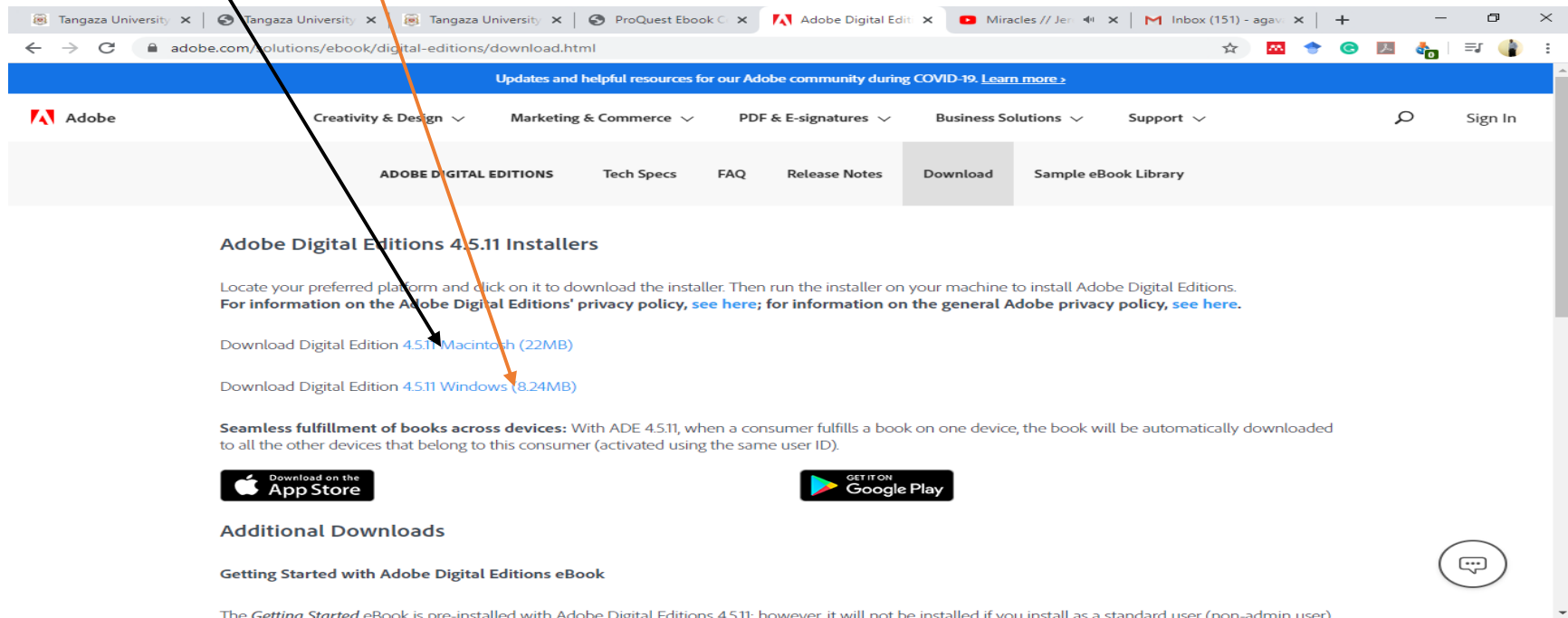
